	1. Here you are in High School planning your future.	
	2. Take the PSAT or PACT test (if available).	Junior year: Fall
	3. Take standardized tests: ACT or SAT (OSU will accept either test). You may retake the test at any time to improve your scores. Read college guides and publications. List colleges you are interested in. OSU offers a residual ACT test that can only be used at OSU. Call (405) 744-5958 for more information.	Junior year: Spring
	4. Call colleges for information. Visit college campuses. Attend college fairs. Meet college representatives.	Senior year: Summer-Fall
	5. Take ACT or SAT test again. List OSU as your first choice so the scores will be sent directly to OSU admissions. Talk to your guidance counselor. Get an "Applying to OSU" packet which includes admission, housing, honors, and scholarship applications. 	6. Apply for admission to OSU. Students must submit: Application for Admission/Scholarships To apply for CASNR scholarships, declare CASNR as your intended college. Don't procrastinate! It is recommended you get the application in early for priority scholarship consideration. ACT or SAT scores High school transcript \$40 application fee Submit OSU housing forms NOW so you will be more likely to get your first choice in housing.	Senior Year: September-October
	7. Apply for Financial Aid. You already completed the scholarship application in the "Applying to OSU" packet. (Priority deadline is February 1.) Get FAFSA forms from your guidance counselor. (Priority deadline is April 1).	Senior Year: January-April
	8. High School Graduation Congratulations! Send OSU your final transcript.	Senior Year: May
	9. The torch is passed. You are accepted at OSU! Celebrate, it's an honor well deserved! Visit campus for a June enrollment conference where you will: Meet your faculty advisor. Select your classes. Get your student ID.	Senior Year: Summer after
	10. Yeah! You are officially a COWBOY! Attend Alpha Week. Move into your residence hall. Buy textbooks. Classes begin.	College Freshman: August
